

Board of Supervisors Meeting - October 16, 2013

The Gage County Board of Supervisors met on October 16, 2013, at 8:47 a.m. with Terry Jurgens, John Hill, Myron Dorn, Matt Bauman, Gary Lytle, Dennis Byars & Kathy Setzer present.
