The presentation of the Veterans Honor Award was postponed until the February 19th meeting.

Motion made by Dorn, seconded by Hill to close bidding at 9:15 a.m. on road signs. Motion carried 7-0.

Bids were received from Newman Signs of Jamestown, ND in the amount of \$38,788.84, Midwest Service and Sales of Schuyler, NE in the amount of \$48,937.49, All Road Barricades Inc. of Lincoln, NE in the amount of \$43,972.41, and Cornhusker State Industries of Lincoln, NE in the amount of \$50,986.70.
